Each year the Kiwanis Club of Berkeley Foundation awards a number of scholarships to deserving graduating seniors from the cities of Berkeley, Albany and El Cerrito. Since our scholarship program was started in 1998, we have awarded scholarships ranging between \$500 and \$10,000 each, and totaling over \$990,000.00

To be considered for the scholarship program, applicants must submit a completed application, three essays, one official transcript and two letters of recommendation.

The Scholarship Committee, based on the strength of the application, will consider applicants who demonstrate academic ability, leadership, a commitment to serve their school and community. For obvious reasons, Kiwanis, as a service organization, is especially interested in community service.

All scholarships are to be used to defray the cost of education. Our checks can be written either to the institution/facility or to the recipient/parent as reimbursement for allowed expenditures (fees, tuition, books, equipment, supplies, board and room). Travel expenses and study outside the 50 United States will not be supported. A single student shall not be awarded more than one Kiwanis scholarship and the financial condition of the applicant or the family will not be a consideration. Certificates will be provided to student winners. These scholarships will expire if not exercised before July 1, 2029.

B. Provide one copy of the Letter of Recommendation Form to **one scholastic** (school related) reference and **one non-school reference** (total of two references). The completed Recommendation (form and letter) may be returned to you (in a sealed envelope suitably identified) for submission or mailed directly to the address below.

C. Obtain or order an official transcript from your high school. It may be mailed directly to the address below, emailed to <u>tamara.paradis@gmail.com</u>, or included in your packet.
